New Live Music Series Kicks Off This Fall

CHESTERFIELD, July 17, 2007 – Chesterfield Arts is pleased to announce the addition of a new live music series, *Fridays Uncorked*, with a kick off performance by Anita Rosamond on October 5. At the 2006 St. Louis Jazz Festival, *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* music critic Kevin Johnson hailed her performance as “the highlight of the Soul School Stage.”

Born in the St. Louis area, pop-jazz vocalist Anita Rosamond began her musical career in her early teens, playing piano, singing and recording with her older brother’s band. Locally, she has performed at Jazz at the Bistro, Finale, the Sheldon Concert Hall, the St. Louis Jazz Festival, and the Old Webster Jazz Festival, among others. In addition to her many appearances in the St. Louis area, Anita has performed across the country, as well as in England and Australia.

“My musical background includes many different influences, and I’ve come to love so many styles of music because of that,” states Anita. “And that allows me to cater to the particular venue and audience where I’m performing.” Don’t miss this special opportunity as Rosamond performs in the intimate setting of The Gallery at Chesterfield Arts; you’ll feel as if you’re watching her from the comfort of your living room with a few close friends.
